

Prof. Dr. Liza Ceciel van Jaarsveldt is an Associate Professor at the University of South Africa (UNISA) in the Department of Public Administration and Management.

She is currently responsible for the tuition of Reflective Public Administration and Research modules and Master and Doctoral supervision.

Her professional efforts have been rewarded with various awards, such as the UNISA Principles Prize for Excellence in Research (2010), and the UNISA Woman in Research – Youngest Ph.D. Award (2011), the best conference paper presentation at the ASSADPAM conference (2018), and the UNISA Excellence in Tuition Award (2020).



Additionally, she received funding from the National Research Foundation in the form of Thuthuka Funding and was a NRF Y2-rated researcher. In terms of research and publications, Liza has authored and co-authored peer-reviewed articles, published conference proceedings, and book chapters on various topics exploring Public Administration education, curriculum development, skills required by the public service and the use of technology in government.

She has acted as an international panel member and keynote speaker. Liza is the IASIA project director for Working Group VIII on Public Human Resource Management.

In 2022, Liza was elected IASIA Board of Management (BoM) member and then appointed as IASIA Functional Vice-President for programmes.
